On arrival:

Students will be accommodated in comfortable individual studio flats. Workshop and rehearsal rooms are numerous. A large library is at the students' disposal. **Costs of transport** to the Les Arcs Draguignan train station or Nice airport are the only costs that the student has to take care of. Traveling fare from a European country can be claimed depending on certain conditions regarding personal resources.

Successful applicants will be invited, **full costs covered**, to spend 12 days on the seminar site at Villecroze (110kms from Nice). Attending students should be available for the whole duration of the master class.
