Students will be accommodated in comfortable individual studio flats. Workshop and rehearsal rooms are numerous. A large library is at the students' disposal. **Costs of transport** to the Les Arcs Draguignan train station or Nice airport are the only costs that the student has to take care of. Traveling fare from a European country can be claimed depending on certain conditions regarding personal resources.

Successful applicants will be invited, full costs covered, to spend 12 days on the seminar site at Villecroze (110kms from Nice). Attending students should be available for the whole duration of the master class.
